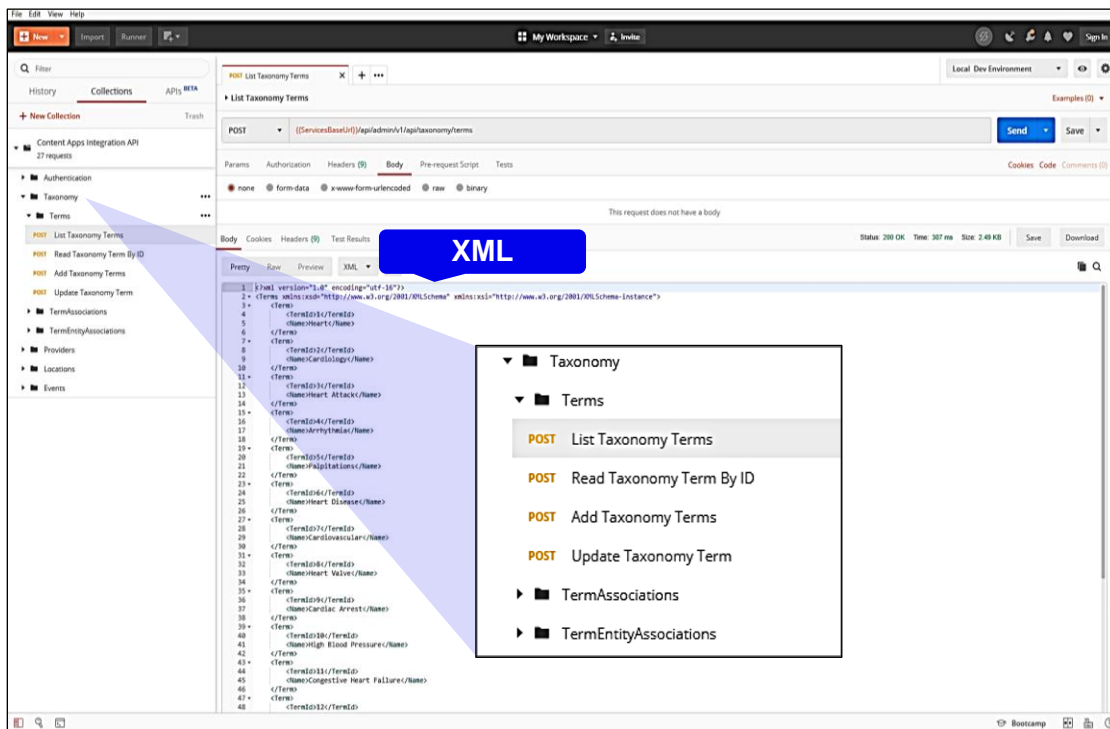


The Taxonomy Integration API

How to Add and Associate Multiple Terms

Previously, the only way to get taxonomy into the system was from within the CMS user interface, by going into the **Terms** list to create and associate new terms with specialties.

Now you can add and manage larger taxonomy lists through the Taxonomy API.





CMS Integration APIs

Manage your taxonomy terms individually or all at once, using the following methods:

Taxonomy

- **Terms**

- List Taxonomy Terms (Get a listing of all terms in the system (current view.))
- Read Taxonomy Term by ID (Fetch a single term by passing in an ID.)
- Add Taxonomy Terms (Add many terms at once by passing multiple term elements in the xml, returning the IDs created for each term.)
- Update Taxonomy Terms (Rename existing terms.)

- **Term Associations**

- List Taxonomy Term Associations
- Add Taxonomy Term Associations
- Update Taxonomy Read Associations
- Read Taxonomy Read Associations

Term Entity Associations

- **Term Entity Associations** (These methods are used for associating points in the Taxonomy Term Association hierarchy to supported entities (currently, *Specialties*).
 - List Taxonomy Term Entity Associations
 - Update Taxonomy Term Entity Associations

*Build out an entire hierarchy of parent/child associations and terms using **Add Taxonomy Term Associations**.*
